

# **IAM Ballot Registration and Voting**

A Ballot Validation ID number will be supplied by your Local or District Lodge Rep. This ID is unique to the ballot created for your vote. This ID will be needed in order to register and vote on your ballot.



Enter your credentials if you have previously registered.


Click the “Forgot your password” link if you do not remember the password you registered with.




## Logging In

When logging in to vote after pre-registration, you **MUST** login with the same information you registered with. So if you registered as a “guest” using your email address, you will need to enter your email address in the “Card No. or Email” field. If you registered with your IMAW card/book number, you will enter that when logging in.
