- Article 8 Seniority
- Article 12 Sick Leave and Special Leaves
- Article 13 Grievance Procedures

The Union and the Company made several passes on wages. We have made positive progress but we believe the Company is continuing to fall short on their offers.

Thank you for your continued support, patience, and solidarity. Your Negotiating Committee will continue to work with the Company for a Collective Bargaining Agreement that our members deserve.
