IAM/PSA STORES CALL FOR CONTRACT PROPOSALS

Dear Sisters and Brothers:

One of the first steps in negotiating your first contract is the official Call for Contract Proposals.

Submitting contract proposals is one way you can be directly involved in negotiating your contract. By telling your union leadership exactly what you want or don't want in your first contract, you will enable them to negotiate effectively, and most importantly, it empowers you by giving you a voice at the negotiating table.

Before submitting proposals, it is essential to understand what a great collective bargaining agreement looks like, how the language reads, and the things you may want to negotiate for yourself and your fellow members. For example, wage rates, premiums, work scope, benefits, safety and health, work rules, and more. We highly recommend you go to the District 142 website at www.atd142.org/, take the time to read through some of the contracts you will find there, and take note of the way the language is written. The American Airlines MLS contract is a great starting point for what you may want to negotiate for your agreement.
