The committee makes the following recommendations:

- 2. Adoptions of standard safety committees across the District.
- 3. A District Safety training program update and process.
- 4. Area Specific safety training given by both the District and Company.
- 5. Company trained First Aid/CPR training with recertification.
- 6. A push for in person Training relying less on CBTs.
- 7. An initiative to update existing CBTs where no in-person training is possible.
- 8. OJT (on the job training) with requirements for retaining and giving access to training records.
- 9. Simplifying communication to make them easier to understand for multiple work groups.
- 10. Multiple solutions to the many situations when working alone.
- 11. To require workplace first aid kits to contain Narcan.

We expect these recommendations to be addressed no later than the next District Convention.
