Dear Candidates:

As we get closer to election day, I would like to help candidates by providing observer guidelines to ensure transparency. Please make note of the following protocols:

1. Candidates must declare their observer via text to (330) 430-9834 or email to troan@iamdl142.org
2. Make every effort to secure an observer well in advance to avoid election-day confusion.
3. Observers may not campaign while performing duties as an observer.
4. Observers must refrain from continuously going in and out of the polling place
5. Observers are allowed to ask tellers questions and make suggestions; however, the District 142 General Chair will serve as the head teller, who has the final word in the event of a dispute.
6. Observing the voting process is exactly that: observing – touching any voting process material is not allowed. During the vote count, tellers may see the ballots, but may not touch them.
7. Observers are not allowed to speak, record, or take pictures.
8. Observers must be members in good standing.
